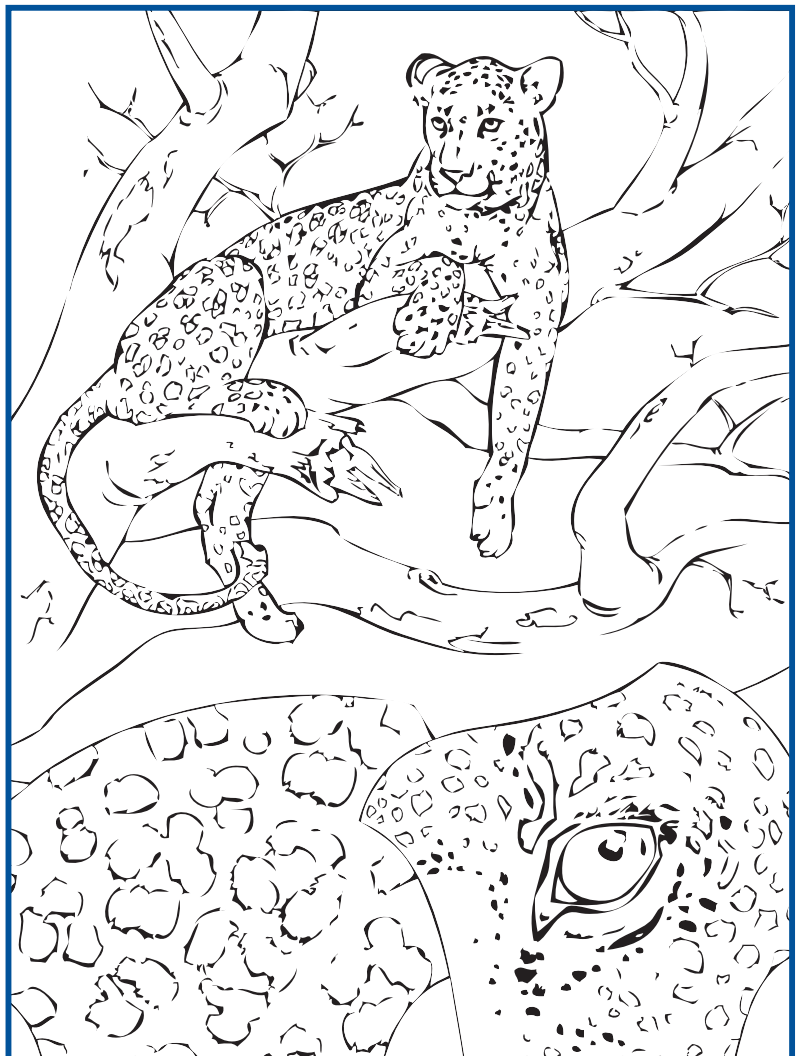
You are one of 10,000 Australian children specially chosen to take part in this important study.

Some interesting facts about you and other kids who are 5-6!

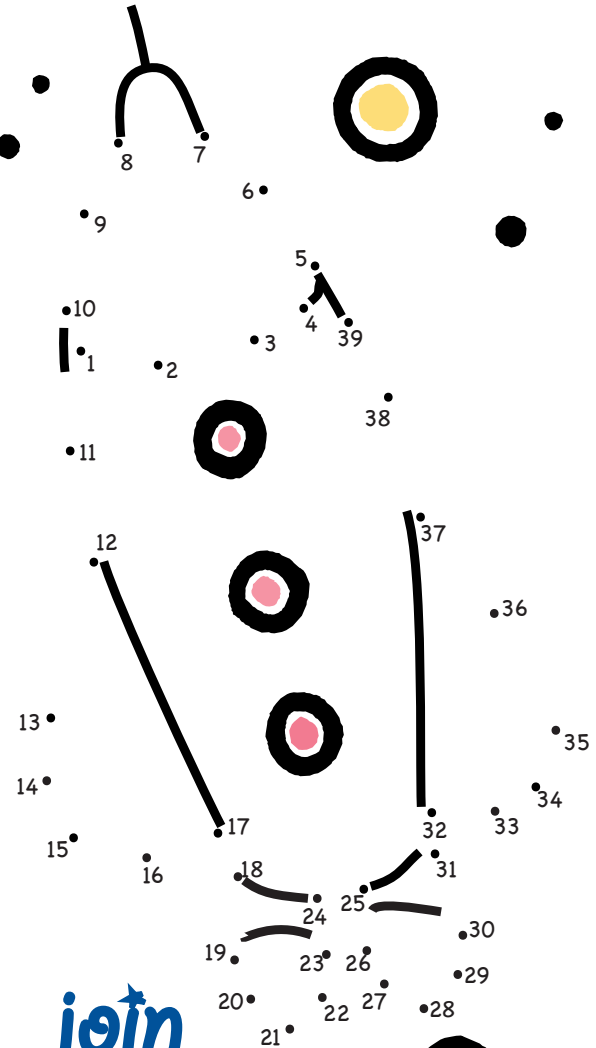
- Some kids go to the movies but a lot more go to playgrounds and swimming pools.
